PROGRAM OUTLINE: The Master degree program is aimed at training highly-competitive professionals who are able to design and organize the process of teaching English as a foreign language, develop traditional and digital teaching resources, and implement a variety of assessment techniques. The dual focus of the program – on Applied Linguistics and TESOL - allows students to acquire deep understanding of the complex relationship between language use and context, as well as get a strong theoretical and practical foundation in the field of teaching English to speakers of other languages. The program equips learners with the linguistic and pedagogic knowledge, research and analytic skills, professional competences in teaching various target audiences and the confidence necessary to develop their careers in ELT. The Master program curriculum is partially aligned with the internationally recognized certification systems of ELT teachers (TESOL, TKT).
